SIT FOR WORSHIP

What is Lent? Lent, more than any other church season invites us to a repentant reflecting, to a changing of the patterns of our lives, to a new dimension of devotion. Lent is the time of the year when we think about our Lord's suffering and death upon the cross, when we remember how much Jesus loves us – enough to give His life to save us from our sins. It is the period of preparation for the celebration of the resurrection of our Lord on Easter Day.

Each of the seasons of the church year is observed and celebrated, but Lent, and only Lent, is "kept." The holy season of Lent invites us to be "keepers"—the people of God who keep the fast, keep the silence, and keep the focus throughout this singular season. The days and weeks of Lent call us to *keep the focus* of our lives of faith on Jesus, our Lord, and to learn more of Him and His loving plan of salvation for us.

When is Lent? Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts all the way to Easter, a 46 day period. If all Sundays are excluded, which have never been days of fasting, there are 40 days of Lent. This reminds us of the 40 days that our Lord spent in the wilderness before He began His public ministry. Moses also fasted and prayed for 40 days. Elijah fasted for 40 days and nights.
