2. **Kindergarten enrollment - If you have a child who will be in Kindergarten next school year, do NOT use the re-enrollment form.** Instead you need to pick up an application in the school office and return it by February 28th. Thank you for your cooperation! **Note: NO fee – fees are incorporated with tuition.**

Therefore it is critical that member families make use of these cards each week as they worship, listing students by name who are in attendance. Our understanding of “Christian Education” is that such education begins and ends in the home, and therefore, worshipping together as a family with fellow members of Christ's Body here at St. Peter is an essential part of our Christian growth as individuals and families. While 75% worship attendance is anticipated for all our students, it is assumed that full tuition families will worship primarily at their home church, and St. Peter member families will worship (with rare exception) at St. Peter.
