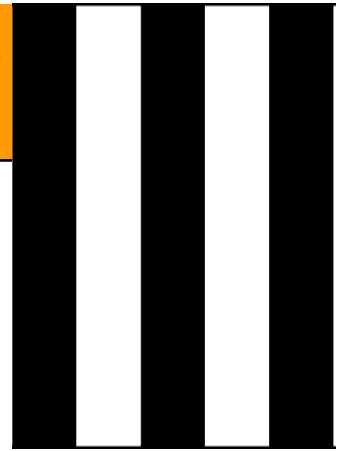

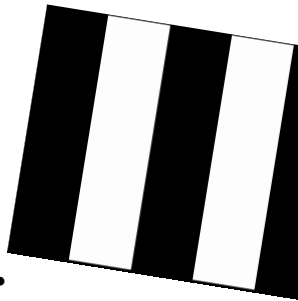

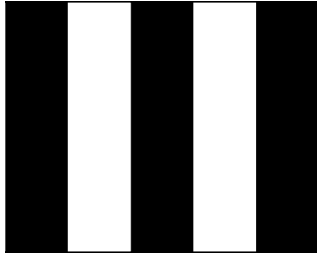

### What Not To Wear

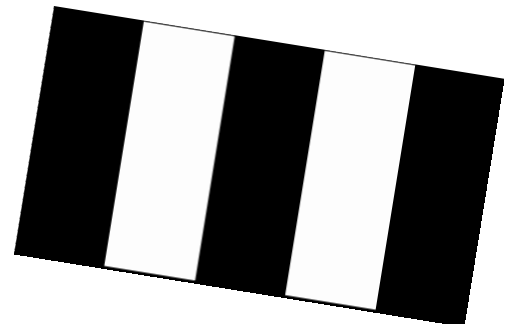
Anything that shows your undergarments or "your stuff" (ex: tank tops, mid riffs, spaghetti straps, etc.)

### “Hoop It Up For The Lord” IV

1. We will have three divisions (high school, 7/8<sup>th</sup> grade, and 5/6<sup>th</sup> grade) with a max of six teams per division. Teams will be placed in a division based on the oldest person on their team (Ex. A team consisting of a 10<sup>th</sup> grader and two 8<sup>th</sup> graders would be placed in the high school division).
2. Teams will consist of a minimum of three players with no more than four players on a roster.
3. Every team will get to play at least three games.
4. The top teams in each division after the first three games are played will have a chance to play in the playoffs/ championship. (Number of teams allowed into the play-offs/championship will be determined by the number of teams registered). Prizes will be awarded to the champion of each division.
5. Girls are welcomed and encouraged to form a team. They can also join with guys to form a team. There will not be a separate division for the ladies though. We will also be using a standard men’s basketball.
6. Games will be played Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup> in the St. Peter Lutheran gym, as well as, outside (weather permitting). All registration and liability forms must be turned into Bo Chapman (at the student ministry center) or into the church office (Attn: Bo Chapman) by Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>. A form with game time information and 3-on-3 rules will be mailed out on Monday, September 21st, to the contact person for each team.
7. Cost of registration is \$40 a team. Make checks payable to St. Peter Lutheran Church and place with your registration and liability information turned in by Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>.
